Rules and Regulations

Set up starts Saturday August 4th at 4 am. All Entrants must be checked in, fully set up and all vehicles removed by 7 am.

All entry forms and fees must be turned in before 07/27/18

Categories for judging are beef brisket, pork ribs, beans and best overall: Pitmaster. (Must enter all categories to qualify for best Pitmaster)

1. Entrants must cook a minimum of 1 brisket, 1 rack of ribs and/or 1 pot of beans. You only need to cook enough for **3-5** judges.
2. At check in, **meat must be raw and thawed**. Preseasoning and premarinating is allowed. Cooking cannot begin until meat(s) have been checked. Not checking in meat can result in **disqualification**.
3. **Alcohol consumption is restricted to the beer garden, drinking of alcohol will not be allowed in the cook off area.** All cooking alcohol MUST be checked in with the meat(s) and MUST be in a non-alcoholic container.
4. Before cooking starts each contestant MUST sign and read a copy of the Health Department regulations. These will be provided at check in.
5. A 10x 20 space will be available for each entrant. Feel free to decorate your space.
6. Contestants must supply their own equipment: (Awnings, tables, BBQ's, etc)
7. A dish washing and hand washing station will be available.
8. Digging of holes or pits will not be permitted. All fires must be in containers, not in the ground.
9. Contestant, for themselves and all persons assisting the Contestant, agree that EVCEA/MOXEE HOP FESTIVAL or City of Moxee, including its officers, and sponsors, are in no way responsible for any loss, damage, or injury to the Contestant and its assistants, regardless of how such loss or injury is incurred and by whom during the Moxee Hop Festival.
10. Entry fee will be \$50 for first entry and \$5 for each additional entry = \$60 for full entry to Pitmaster
11. Prizes are as stated for brisket, pork ribs, beans and best overall. Pitmaster: Trophy and cash prize. 1st through 3rd Place: Trophy, cash & prize package. (To qualify for best overall prize you must enter all three categories.) The 2018 Chicken and Beer mini contest will not be included for Pitmaster qualifier.
12. Entries must be ready for judging at 3 p.m. with beans being the first category up for judging. The BBQ Committee will inform entrants how to submit entries for judging. Judging will be from 3:00 to 6:00 p.m. approximately.
13. GARNISHES will be allowed to be added to entries at judge's time. Presentation helps but will not be judged.
14. Due to Health Department rules and codes, entrants will not be allowed to sell food.
15. Winners will be announced and prizes will be awarded after judging (estimated 6:00 p.m.)
16. Decisions of the contest committee and judges are final.
17. Contest Committee, Hop Festival Committee and the EVCEA board reserve the right to additional regulations as situations warrant.
18. Each entrant will be responsible for the cleanup of his or her space.
