PARADE RULES, REGULATIONS AND SCHEDULE

8:00AM CHECK IN OPENS IN FRONT OF THE MOXEE CITY HALL/ POLICE STATION
8:30AM JUDGING OF ROYALTY ENTRIES TAKES PLACE
10:00AM PARADE BEGINS

COME JOIN US AT 7:00AM FOR BREAKFAST IN THE PARK

1. Entrants must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow all instructions from police or parade officials. The East Valley Community Enhancement Association and the Parade Committee reserve the right to remove any entrant from the parade either prior to assembly, at assembly or at any time during the parade.
2. The EVCEA and its Parade Committee reserve the right to withdraw any unit of which the costume or performance does not meet these rules and regulations, or does not conform to the standards of reasonable community taste and decency.
3. Floats, or any other units, advocating, opposing or depicting any social or religious issues are subject to approval of the EVCEA/ Moxee Hop Festival Parade Committee.
4. Entries that do not fully comply with the rules and regulations, jeopardize future invitations to the Moxee Hop Festival Parade.
5. Entries wishing to be judged other than Bands and Drill Teams must be in the staging area by 8:30am. The staging area is on ([Charron Road](#)). You will be told where to go! See Parade map. Maps will also be available upon sign in.
6. The Parade Committee's decision regarding all entrants, their eligibility, placement and judging is final.
7. Applications received after August 1st, 2009 deadline, may not be eligible for judging or awards.
8. All entries arriving after registration has closed and still wants to be in parade may line up at the very end on a first come first serve basis.
9. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, vehicle or on the person of any parade participant. No profanity is allowed along the parade route or within the assembly areas.
10. Any motorized vehicle throwing candy must provide (1) walker on each side of vehicle to secure the safety of children.
11. All sirens, horns and excessive noise to be held until after the singing of the National Anthem and Color Guard has presented.
12. Only forward movement maneuvers are permitted along the parade route. A spacing of 35 feet between each unit will be enforced. All units are required to open or close the gap between units when asked to do so by parade officials.
13. All equestrian units or other units with live animals must provide their own clean up crew. The Crews must pick up dropping in the staging area as well as in the Parade!
14. Political candidates, political organizations, commercial businesses, and any for profit organization will be charged a \$25.00 entry fee. Contributions made to East Valley Community Enhancement Association may be applied toward this entry fee at the discretion of the EVCEA Board upon the request of the applicant.
15. All floats with engine or motorize capability, must provide evidence of insurance for bodily injury and property damage with a combined single limit of \$200,000 or split limits of \$150,000 each person and \$400,000 each occurrence bodily injury liability and \$100,000 property damage liability. A Certificate of Liability Insurance must be provided with, East Valley Community Enhancement Association, City of Moxee, named as additional insured. **This certificate of insurance must be received with your entry application. The certificate of insurance has to come from your Insurance Company! (It's NOT the insurance identification card you carry in your car!)**
16. The EVCEA does not accept the responsibility for traveling expenses, food, lodging or any other expenses of the parade entry.
