PARADE CHECK-IN POINT:

The parade check-in area will be located at the Moxee Police Station located at 7525 Postma Rd. All parade vehicles must enter from Beaudry Rd. (Off of HWY 24), and should park in the turn lane while checking in. Once checked in you will be escorted to your place in line. Check in time is 4:00 PM to 5:30 PM. Each entry will receive a pre-assigned number at the check in point, to be displayed on the DRIVER side of the entry. Entries will line up on Postma Rd. You will be lined up as you check in.

Passenger Drop-Off Zone

For the safety and security of everyone involved, ALL parade passengers and/or drivers that arrive after your parade entry is lined up must be dropped off in the designated "Parade Drop-off Zone." Due to the number of pedestrians walking around the parade line-up, ABSOLUTELY NO CARS WILL BE ALLOWED onto N. Iler St. or past Rivard & Postma.

Designated drop off location is the corner of West Charron & North Rivard. You can access W. Charron & N. Rivard from West Moxee Avenue off of HWY 24. Please make sure to use the sidewalks to get to your designated spots.

JUDGING

All parade entries must be in place for judging that will take place at 5:00 PM. Parade entries not in their assigned positions at this time will not be judged.

PARADE ROUTE

Starting from Postma Rd., parade entrants will enter Iler and head south. The parade route will proceed through downtown Moxee. For those wanting to display their entries for the public you are welcome to park in the Cul de sac at the end of Iler, ending just past The River Church where Santa will be available for photos. Those wanting to head out are welcome to turn RIGHT onto E. Seattle Ave, and then LEFT onto Rivard and head out towards HWY24.

PARADE RULES:

All entries must be completely lighted (stringing up a few lights on a tractor or truck will not be accepted) and the entry decoration/lighting must represent the holiday season. No entries conveying controversial/irreverent messages and/or political statements will be allowed to participate in the parade.

PLEASE NO LIVE SANTA'S ON YOUR ENTRIES. Santa has already committed to our parade; we don't want to confuse the littles. Thank you for understanding.

FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL SPECTATORS AND CHILDREN:

- You MUST have proof of insurance to participate in the Moxee Lighted Parade. •
- NO candy or other objects shall be thrown *from* the parade vehicles/floats or otherwise distributed along the • parade route.
- All parade vehicles/floats must be operated by a licensed driver, in a safe manner, at all times. NO drugs/alcohol are permitted!

The parade organizers reserve the right to reject entry applications not in conformance with the rules/them of the Moxee Lighted Parade. Further, parade entries in violation of these rules or operated in an unsafe/dangerous manner will be removed from the parade.

AWARDS:

Awards will be given in each of the parade divisions. The Sweepstakes Award (Plaque and \$500) will be presented to the entry which best represents the spirt of the 5th Annual Moxee Lighted Parade in both the float division and commercial division. The awards will be presented at the corner of Postma & Iler. In addition, an award will be given to winners in each of the categories.

JUDGING:

An impartial committee of qualified persons shall be responsible for judging the event.

Insurance Requirements

Floats: All floats with engine or motorize capability must provide evidence of insurance for bodily injury and property damage with a combined single limit of \$200,000 or split limits of \$150,000 each person or \$400,000 each occurrence bodily injury, liability and \$100,000 property damage liability. The certificate of insurance must be provided with the EVCEA and City of Moxee named as additional insured.

Vehicles: If there is a vehicle (other than a float) in your entry, **the following must be filled out:**
